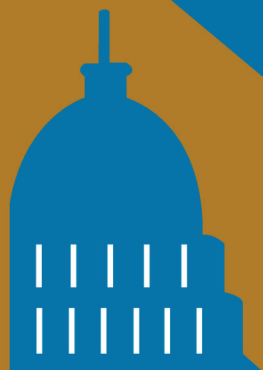

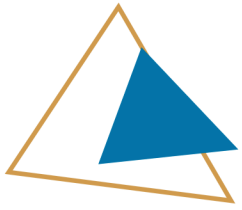
BECOMING A CHAMPION

Individuals and groups begin with **The Champions Academy**. These Champion Citizens will learn together, support one another, and begin to put plans of engagement together using our academy resources.

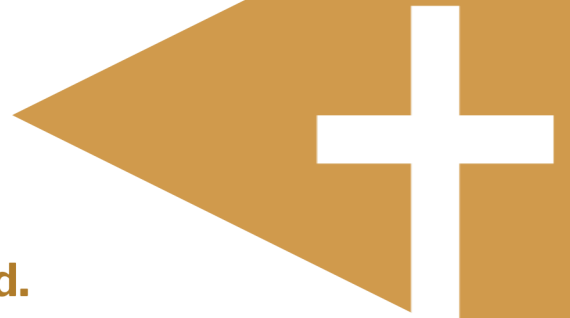
Churches can support their members by participating in **The Champions Church**. We work with pastors and leadership and help provide extra support for their Champion Citizens.

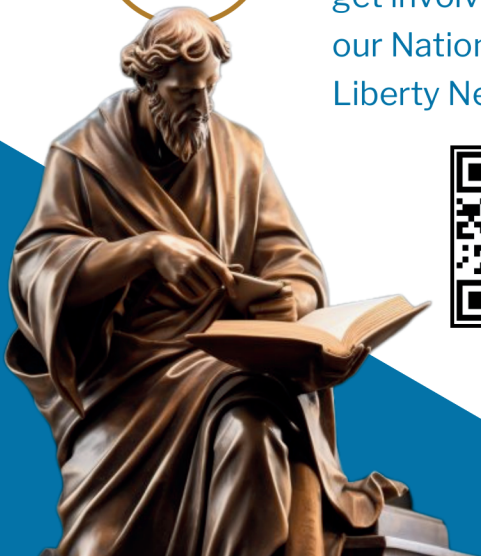
Host an Event.
