Dear Beloved of God the Father!

Is it harvest time? Not just for farmers and in the corn and bean fields, but perhaps also for the souls of men

and women, boys and girls?!?!?

Something has happened in our nation (any number of things!) that has sparked a spiritual revival! People who haven't gone to church in decades have walked through the doors. Folks who have never read the Bible are reading it for the first time. Others are praying like never before, seeking the Lord and leading their children to a life of faith in Jesus. Do we see it happening here? I long to see more than a trickle of the rivers of revival!

Pray! Pray! Pray! There is little we can do to move the timetable of God, but as we know that He desires all to be saved and come to a knowledge of the Truth (Jesus!), we do have a role to play in the advance of the Kingdom of God among us. Let me commend to you a couple of things as "our part" while we anticipate the power of God to be manifest among us:

1. Be in the Word! Daily feed your faith! What you are full of will easily flow out of you! Perhaps plug yourself into a Bible study – put in some extra time and do it with others that are wanting God's will and work to go forward in our world!

- 2. Worship consistently! Be the day and time Sunday at 8:15am or 10:30am, first Saturdays at 5pm, or even remotely or by a delayed broadcast. It is hard to think that people who are physically able still don't make it to church even 50% of weekends. If worship is low priority, such a person is more likely "worshiping" a lesser god of pleasure, entertainment, or self-will.
- 3. Pray for the Holy Spirit to empower you daily to "let your light shine". You won't have to go out of your way, but the Spirit will lead you in all your ways and see who God puts in your path to influence for good and toward greater faith and Godly living.
- 4. Consider that the Holy Spirit is working to "sanctify" you make you more like Jesus! Don't be slow to ask yourself the question, "What would Jesus do? What would Jesus not do?" and you be the right answer.

As we know and grow to know better the wonderful love of Jesus from which nothing can separate us, we can't help but grieve the sadness, evil and brokenness of this world, our nation, and our community. Nonetheless we are not overcome by the bad, but we are instruments in the Lord's hands to overcome that evil by doing good.

What a good place to be – in HIS HANDS!




