From the Pastor

Dear Citizens!

What is that old Shakespeare line? "Friends, Romans, Countrymen, lend me your ear . . ." It is Marc Antony speaking at Julius Caesar's funeral.

Today's call is to friends, Americans, and all the citizens of planet Earth! The call is to look to but also beyond the great 250th anniversary of the Declaration of Independence. I dare say the whole world should be thankful for the United States of America, especially its citizens, people privileged with living in this great nation of unparalleled freedom and prosperity (probably rivaled by ancient Israel under the rule and reign of kings David and his son, Solomon). It is interesting to read/hear the comments of foreigners here in the USA for the World Cup Soccer tournament. The vast majority are loving America, even saying that what they'd previously heard on news media outlets about the USA were all lies. They recognize the freedom and liberty, and most Americans love their country.

We should be thankful for our blessings here but not lose sight of the Scriptural truth that "our citizenship is in heaven"! (Phil. 3:20). That will hold great blessings and is so much more to be thankful for than our temporal dwelling in this country. You don't even have to apply for heaven's citizenship. It is given to you! It is offered to all – "whosoever believeth"! With it comes freedom from sin, liberation from death, and the promise perfect peace and joy in eternity. The citizenship comes with knowing/coming to trust Jesus as Savior. HE is the ultimate Commander in Chief! His Kingdom will never end! And though He was betrayed and struck down like Caesar by Brutus, unlike Julius Caesar, Jesus arose from death and will never die again. He lives and reigns to all eternity! He is the One who gives us LIFE and LIFE ETERNAL.

I agree with those who have said that if we forget our history as Americans, we are likely to lose our freedom. We need to cele-

brate in remembrance the deeds of God through our Fore Fathers. We need to learn - for many it will be new learning and not a "refresher course" – the faith of our fathers, the likes of Washington, Jefferson, Franklin, John and John Quincy Adams, Noah Webster, Patrick Henry, and Daniel Webster.

Still, I am more concerned about those losing the faith of their parents and grandparents right now, in this time and in our generation. Many have forgotten the Gospel deeds of God's grace. They diminish the sacrifice of Jesus but not thinking on it, hearing about it, praising and worshipping Him for it. Many need a refresher course, a wake-up call, a "revival". Still, others have never heard! They need to hear it and see it in the lives of heaven's citizens, through our "talk and walk".

It was President Ronald Reagan who said, "Freedom is never more than one generation away from extinction." If we don't fight for it and defend it, freedom can be lost and never recovered.



Spiritual freedom is like that in many ways! We must fight the good fight of faith and defensively hold on to that faith in Jesus as our top priority when the devil, the world, and our own sinful flesh try to minimize its value and importance in our daily lives, let alone our weekly worship. Sunday mornings have long, long been set aside for rest, spiritual refreshment, and refocusing. While any day and any time are good for faith-building, we miss something significant if we are not contributing to "public worship". As many church congregations fade in membership and participation, the next generation is in jeopardy of not even having an open house of worship or a pastor to care for their souls.

Keep telling the stories (and learning the stories) of America and its founding, its principles of LIFE, LIBERTY, and the Pursuit of Happiness! But especially keep hearing, learning, and telling the old, old story of Jesus and His love!

Medical Equipment For Loan

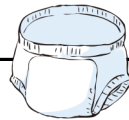
St. Paul has a medical equipment loan program.

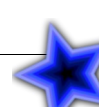

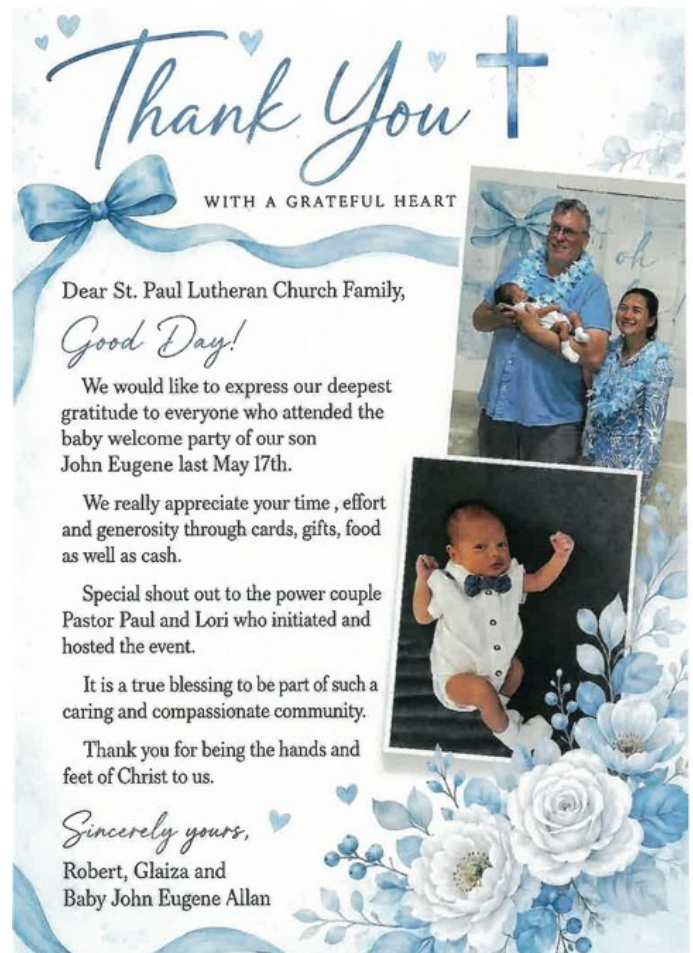
