




Lent #5 – Apr. 6 – "The Wedding Gift" - The wedding at Cana and Jesus is all about loving people.

Greetings! To those "in Christ", YOU are a new creation!

"The old has passed away and behold the new has come!" (2 Cor. 5:17)

Do you know *anyone* who is sad to see winter come to an end? We may enjoy snow for Christmas, and we can tolerate a little cold weather in January, but by the end of March and beginning of April, we are dying for Spring.


Looking forward to the summer and all the amazing things we have planned for the kids to do.
